The mission of Trike Theatre is to Cultivate Creativity, Build Character, and Strengthen Community through its vision of transforming the lives of young people through exceptional theatre experiences.

Description of Position

The Trike Academy Teaching Artist is responsible for leading Academy classes and camps Tricycle Theatre for Youth. Secondary responsibility is to help build relationships with students and parents as well as mentoring Teaching Apprentices under the guidance of the Academy Manager.

Core Job Duties:

- Create and implement original lesson plans that are in alignment with the core standards set by Trike Theatre.
- Additionally, the candidate will follow and implement pre designed lesson plans by Trike Theatre.
- Mentor Teaching Apprentice in the classroom.
- Manage teacher/parent communication through Trike's digital class registration software (Jackrabbit Class).



- Work with off-site satellite location community partners.
- Implement student evaluation forms.
- Work with Academy Manager to build skills and ability in the classroom.
- Cultivate a culture of belonging and I-DARE values (Inclusivity, diversity, anti-racism and equity)
